Childhood trauma and toxic stress threaten healthy development and plant the seeds for physical and mental illness. Join CTE educators and the Department of Education's Teri Lawler for a spirited discussion to explore the science of early brain development—what promotes it, what derails it, and the consequences of each – and put action behind your compassion to change the trajectory for youth, families, and communities. Participants will play The Brain Architecture Game and observe up close how educators and community members can work together to build resilience and coping skills, lessen the impact of challenging life events at critical milestones, and improve outcomes for youth through healing-centered engagement and trauma-responsive interventions and supports that add value to every learning environment.
