Career and Technical Education Month Poster Contest

Who May Enter:

Any student enrolled in grades 5-12 of a Delaware public, charter or private school may submit a poster. Career and Technical Education students are especially encouraged to participate.

Deadline:

Completed poster designs must be postmarked or emailed before midnight on December 2, 2025. All entries become the property of the Delaware Advisory Council on Career and Technical Education (DACCTE) and will not be returned.

This Year's Theme: "Turn Your Passion into a Profession"

Poster Specifications and Contest Rules:

- Completed posters should be at least 8.5" x 11" and no larger than 12" x 18" if mailed. All submissions either poster or digital should be **portrait oriented.**
- The Career and Technical Education Month Poster Contest entry form must be submitted with information typed or printed clearly and securely attached to the back of any mailed poster. If the submission is digital, the entry form must be sent with the same entry email together. The entry form must be signed by parent/guardian.
- Any digital entry must come from a teacher or administrator email from the student's school of record.
- Posters will be judged on originality, clarity of message and quality of artwork. The
 decision of the judges will be final.
- Posters must contain the image of a compass somewhere in the design.
- All posters and slogans must harmonize with the theme of Career and Technical Education Month.
- Entrants agree to give DACCTE ownership of their artwork with the right to reproduce it.
- Winners will be notified by phone, mail, and/or e-mail by January 23, 2026.
